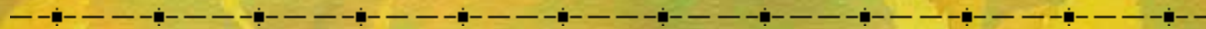

I. How Much Waste is There?



10-15% of all construction materials are waste

Enough lumber to frame +2,000 single family homes annually



10-12% is cardboard alone

Waste from construction accounts for up to 40% of the nation's solid waste



8,000 lbs of waste is created from the construction of a 2,000 square foot home. The majority of the 8,000 is wood, drywall and cardboard

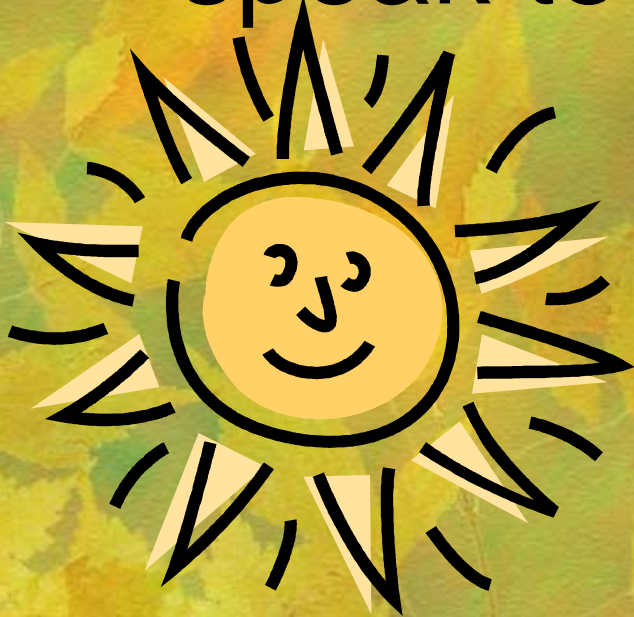
