StopWaste is the Alameda County Waste Management Authority, the Alameda County Source Reduction and Recycling Board, and the Energy Council operating as one public agency.

**Subject: Quarterly Disbursement of Measure D Revenues July – September, 2018**

The Alameda County Waste Reduction and Recycling Initiative (Measure D), levies a surcharge on solid waste landfilled in unincorporated Alameda County. Fifty percent of Recycling Fund revenues are disbursed to cities and sanitary districts that meet criteria contained in the law. Funds disbursed to municipalities must be used "...for the continuation and expansion of municipal recycling programs." The quarterly Measure D disbursement for your jurisdiction, covering the period July – September, 2018, is enclosed with the copy of this letter sent to your staff Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) representative or designee. Per Board policy, the population numbers are adjusted to CA Dept. of Finance Table E-5 data in even numbered years for disbursements made at the end of August. Population numbers were updated in August 2018 in accordance with board policy. Updated population numbers per city can be found in the attached document titled Chart of Allocations.

Annual Measure D Reporting forms were submitted at the end of October by member agencies using the on-line web portal. StopWaste staff have been reviewing submittals and may follow up with member agency staff for clarifications and/or request additional supporting documentation.

We are in the process of updating our Measure D communications and correspondence protocols; currently we mail the Measure D check, original letter and other correspondences to the appropriate staff person identified by the member agency. Copies of the check and correspondences are also mailed to TAC, member agency recycling staff and Authority members. In the spirit of source reduction, starting next quarter, we will only be mailing one set of Measure D hard copy correspondences (Measure D check, original letter and other relevant Measure D items) to the identified member agency staff who currently receive the Measure D check. All other recipients of Measure D correspondences will receive the documents via email. If your member agency would prefer to continue to receive hard copies in lieu of an email, please advise StopWaste staff Meri Soll at [msoll@stopwaste.org](mailto:msoll@stopwaste.org) of this preference prior to February 1, 2019.
