

ARTICLE VI. - WASTE MANAGEMENT PLANS

21-24 - WASTE MANAGEMENT PLANS.

23-24.1 - Projects Subject to Waste Management Plan (WMP) Requirement.

- a. Mandatory Compliance. All projects within the City, including City-sponsored projects, which the City reasonably det dollars or more to construct shall be subject to the WMP requirement of subsection 21-24.1A. Failure to comply wi infraction pursuant to subsection 1-5.1 of this Code. For purposes of this provision, one or more permits for constr (as for example, the time between the application for the initial approval and the issuance of a certificate of occupa and with respect to the same premises or with respect to multiple premises owned by the same person shall be de determines that treating such permits as involving multiple projects will not obstruct the accomplishment of the projects.
- b. Voluntary Compliance. Applicants for permits for construction, demolition, and renovation Projects which the Buildi hundred thousand (\$100,000.00) dollars to construct shall be encouraged to divert at least fifty (50%) percent of all applicants shall be required to make a good faith effort toward diversion.
- Compliance as a Condition of Approval. Compliance with the provisions of this Article shall be a condition of approva
 and the Building Official shall provide the applicant written notice of that fact.

21-24.1A - Submission of Waste Management Plans.

- a. WMP Forms. Applicants for building or demolition permits valued at more than one hundred thousand (\$100,000.0 Plan ("WMP") on a form approved by the Public Works Director. Applicants certifying that they have employed the 21-20 shall be exempt from the filing of a WMP but shall meet the standards of subsection 21-24.3 of this chapter.
 - 1. The estimated volume or weight of C&D debris, by materials type, to be generated;
 - 2. The maximum volume or weight of such materials that can feasibly be diverted via reuse or recycling;
 - 3. The vendor or facility that the C&D Applicant proposes to use to collect or receive that material; and
 - 4. The estimated volume or weight of C&D materials that will be sent to a disposal site.
- Calculating Volume and Weight of Debris. In estimating the volume or weight of materials identified in the WMP, the City for this purpose.




