

Metallic Mercury Health Effects

Prolonged or acute exposure:

- Tremors
- Headaches
- Insomnia
- Emotional changes such as mood swings, irritability, excessive shyness
- Neuromuscular weakness, muscle atrophy, twitching
- Poor performance on tests of mental function

Higher exposures may also cause kidney effects, respiratory failure and death.

Older Buildings

- Thermostats
 - Locate recycling site
 - 15 San Francisco area drop off sites
 - https://www.thermostat-recycle.org/
- Gas Pressure Regulators installed prior to 1968
 - Contain approximately 2 teaspoons of mercury
 - Contact local gas company for safe removal
- **Boiler Heating Systems**
 - Honeywell Heat Generators
 - Found near boiler in basement or radiator
