Hazardous wastes generated from living in and maintaining your residence. Common types of household hazardous waste accepted include:

Paints & coatings, roof coating, thinner, paint remover, adhesive, tar, cement, grout

Cleaners, bleach: detergent, dish soap, disinfectants, bathroom & oven cleaner

Auto care products: fuel, antifreeze, oils, grease, oil filters, wax, sprays

Garden Products: fertilizer, pesticides, weed killer, soil treatments, camp & BBQ fuel

Pool and Spa chemicals, photo chemicals, art chemicals, spray paint

Cosmetics, hair products, vitamins, nail polish, aerosols, hair spray

Batteries, fluorescent and HID lamps, thermometers, thermostats, BBQ Propane

Electronic Waste: consumer electronics with a circuit board, including

Computers, Televisions, Radios, Printers, Microwave ovens, phones, cameras

Medical Items:

SHARPS are accepted PACKED IN FDA CLEARED SHARPS CONTAINERS

DRUGS or Biohazard material **ARE NOT accepted at the HHW facilities.**

Take any drugs to kiosks at a drugstore, law enforcement site or clinic

NOT ACCEPTABLE:

Asbestos

Treated wood waste: pressure treated or RR ties

Appliances: Refrigerators, Washers, Dryers, Air Conditioners, Stoves

Radioactive Material **Explosives** (call re: ammo, fireworks, marine flares)

Gas Cylinders (Propane tanks smaller than 5 gal OK)

Who Can Come:

Alameda County residents transporting wastes they generated in the course of living in and maintaining their place of residence. This includes homeowners, renters, residents of a condo, apartment, house, trailer park, boat berthed in the county

Bring and be ready to show driver's license, Calif. ID or proof of residence

WHO CAN'T COME:

How to Package:

No individual container may be greater than 5 gallons or 50 pounds in size

All materials must be packaged in non-leaking, closed containers

Place a leaking item in a larger container that won't leak, like a bucket with lid

Include original product labels or a note with what you know about unmarked items

Do not mix different wastes in the same container

Load safely in back of vehicle: upright, braced so will not: slide, tip over, spill, break

At the HHW facility our staff will unload your waste. Please drive carefully!

How Much How Often:

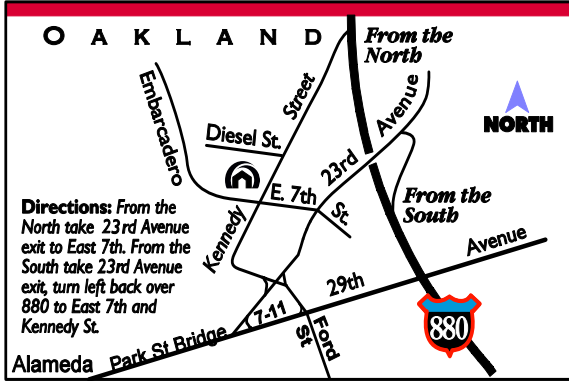
State law limits the total amount you may transport in a vehicle to 125 pounds or 15 gallons. Wastes must be transported by or with a resident of the household which generated the waste. You may deliver as many times as you like.

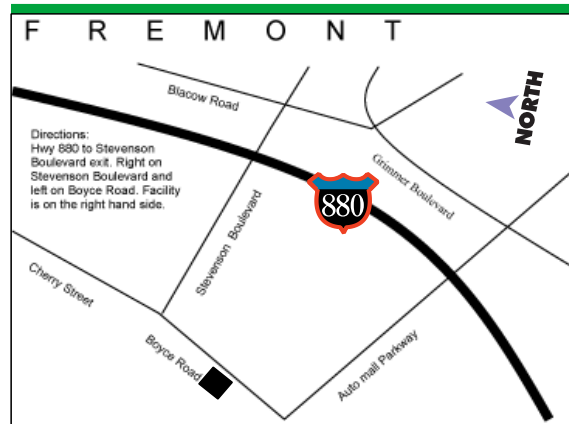
