

Alameda County Household Hazardous Waste Business Drop - In Service for disposal of:

Aerosol Cans, Household Batteries, Lamps and Latex Paint

Any Alameda County business or organization Universal Waste handler is eligible to use the Business Drop-In Service.

Business Drop-In Service days and hours open:

Hayward HHW facility: 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month, 9:00AM to 12:00PM

Livermore HHW facility: 2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month, 9:00AM to 12:00PM, closed weeks of Thanksgiving & Christmas

Oakland HHW facility: Every Tuesday, 9:00AM to 12:00PM, closed week of Thanksgiving and Christmas Holidays

See flyer back/Bill of Lading for facility addresses. No account setup or appointment needed.

General Requirements:

Costs are calculated and must be paid at delivery by Visa, Mastercard or cash. \$ 25.00 minimum charge per delivery.

The back of the flyer may be used as a Bill of Lading for transport and to help estimate cost.

Batteries lamps must be intact and safely packaged to prevent breakage or short circuit. Boxes for lamps available for purchase.

999 Lb. maximum per vehicle/ trip to comply with Department of Transportation placarding rules.

Wastes Accepted:

- **Aerosol Cans:** any type of aerosol up to 16.4 oz in size, full or empty
- **Batteries:** rechargeable & single use – Pack each type of batteries in a separate container, max. 500 Lbs. per delivery

Batteries below require terminals to be insulated – cover each terminal with non-conductive tape or place each battery in a strong plastic bag and seal closed.

- **Sealed Lead-Acid (SLA)** up to 11 Lbs. 40 Ah, each terminal must be insulated, no liquid electrolyte
- **Lithium-ion (LION):** packs up to 300 Wh, cells up to 20 Wh capacity, each terminal insulated, max. 66 Lbs./container
- **Lithium Metal:** up to 1 gram lithium /cell, 2 grams lithium /battery, each terminal insulated, max 11 Lbs./container
- **Nickel Cadmium & Nickel Metal Hydride (NiCd & NiMH)** – batteries over 9 volt capacity each terminal insulated
- **Alkaline and Carbon Zinc** – batteries over 9 volt capacity each terminal insulated
- **Damaged, Defective, Recalled Lithium-Ion batteries** up to 300 Wh. Pack each separately, sealed in a clear plastic bag, pack in layers of non-combustible absorbent, in non-combustible container. Max. 66 Lbs./container

Batteries not accepted: auto batteries, batteries with liquid electrolyte, motive power, home or solar power batteries

- **Lamps:** Fluorescent, LED and Mercury/Sodium high intensity discharge (HID) lamps are accepted. Lamps must be intact and unbroken, packed in a closed container. Broken mercury-containing lamps are managed as Hazardous Waste and not accepted for Drop-In Service
- **Latex paint:** Accepted in closed, non-leaking containers up to 5 gallons in size, maximum 1000 pounds (Lbs.) per delivery

Not Accepted:

Other hazardous waste, electronic waste, mercury-containing equipment, photovoltaic modules, trash, appliances, construction materials. The Business Drop-In Service DOES NOT accept oil-based paint or any other hazardous waste.

Lamps, Straight, greater than 2 foot long , intact, fluorescent & LED cost \$2.00 per pound	
Lamps, Compact , intact, fluorescent & LED cost \$3.00 per pound straight lamps up to 2 foot long, D tubes, U tubes, PL inserts, compact LEDs	
Lamps, High Intensity (HID) , intact cost \$4.00 per pound auto headlights, Hg Vapor, UV lamps, Sodium Vapor, Metal Halide, Arc lamps, video projector
