**Subject: Quarterly Disbursement of Measure D Revenues Jan.-March, 2014**

Dear:

The Alameda County Waste Reduction and Recycling Initiative (Measure D), levies a surcharge on solid waste landfilled in unincorporated Alameda County. Fifty percent of Recycling Fund revenues are disbursed to cities and sanitary districts that meet criteria contained in the law. Funds disbursed to municipalities must be used "...for the continuation and expansion of municipal recycling programs."

Enclosed with the copy sent to your staff Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) representative or designee please find the quarterly Measure D disbursement for your jurisdiction, covering the period January - March 2014 (Attachment A).

The next disbursement will be made at the end of August for the April-June quarter and will contain the Annual Measure D Programs Report for FY 13/14 and the annual solid waste data request, to be completed and returned prior to the subsequent allocation in November.
