1. Municipal Panel: SB 1383 Implementation (Meghan Starkey)

Timothy Burroughs introduced the item. Meghan Starkey provided an overview of the staff report and presented a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Starkey introduced Angela Vincent, Alameda; Elizabeth Carrade, Albany; Allyn McAuley, Fremont; and Judy Erlandson, Livermore. The topic focused on local implementation of SB 1383, the Short-Lived Climate Pollutant Reduction Act, which requires a 75% reduction in statewide disposal of organics and 20% of edible food recovered for human consumption. Each presenter discussed their various programs and approaches to meeting this mandate in their cities.
