## **Print Services** (Paper-Based)



## Use this Guide When Purchasing

Print services for paper-based print jobs

Print services are often used for high-volume print jobs, mailers, and specialty printing. If your agency directly uses the resulting print job materials, the paper used for the print job must contain a minimum of 30% post-consumer recycled content to comply with California's Senate Bill 1383, aka. SB 1383, which went into effect January 2022.



#### **How to Purchase**

Check with your central procurement office or administrative staff to find out if you have any contracts or preferred vendors that employees are required to use for print services. Before initiating the print job order, ensure the vendor can provide paper that meets the following Minimum Requirements.

## Product Requirements- specify or seek:

#### MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS/SPECIFICATIONS

- 30% post-consumer recycled content, AND
- For print jobs using 20# white copy or multipurpose paper, the paper has at least one of the following certifications:
  - Green Seal
  - FSC certified "Recycled" or "Mix"

## SB 1383 Reporting Requirements

Coordinate with your agency's SB 1383 lead to maintain required documentation, including:

- Records verifying the minimum recycled content of the paper product
- Written documentation from the vendor certifying that the paper product is recyclable
- Invoices or other proofs of purchase that include paper type and volume details

#### **LEADERSHIP OPPORTUNITIES**

Minimum Requirements plus one or more of the following:

#### Vendor:

- Certified as a California Green Business
- Certified B-Corporation

#### Paper:

- 50-100% post-consumer recycled content
- Green Seal or FSC certified "Recycled" or "Mix"
- Any non-post-consumer recycled content fiber is agricultural residue fiber
- Bleaching process is Processed Chlorine Free (PCF)
- Made with Green-e certified renewable energy



## **Related Tips**

## Reduce costs and/or waste by:

- Designing print media to be double-sided.
- Designing print media with no-ink edges (reduces paper waste compared to using bleed-to-edge designs).
- For reoccurring events, designing key media to be reusable (e.g., durable, no date-specific content).
- Limiting the use of dark or brightly colored papers, as they are more difficult to recycle.

## **ABOUT SENATE BILL 1383**

SB 1383 (14 CCR 18993.3 et seq.) set methane emission reduction targets for California, with a focus on reducing organic waste to landfills — a key source of methane emissions. The regulations established purchasing requirements for recycled content paper to ensure strong markets for recovered paper and to keep paper out of landfills.

B Corp Certification is a designation that a business is meeting high standards of verified performance, accountability, and transparency on factors from employee benefits and charitable giving to supply chain practices and input materials.
