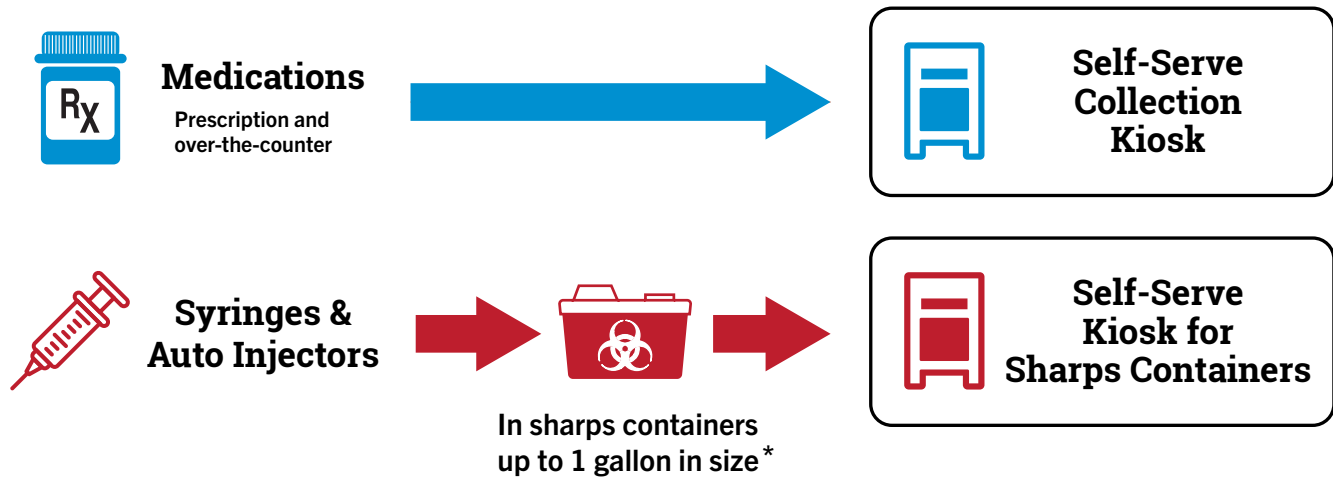




Safe Medicine Disposal in Alameda County

Medicines should never be flushed down the toilet or placed in the trash, unless specifically stated on the packaging. Instead, unused or expired medicine should be dropped off at a collection kiosk. Sharps should be placed in FDA approved sharps containers and brought to a location that accepts sharps. See reverse side for a list of kiosk locations.



- * Larger containers and problematic sharps may be taken to an HHW facility. Free Mailback containers for sharps are available from Med Project (med-project.org, 1-844-633-7765) or Novo Nordisk (novocare.com, 1-877-765-3030).

PLEASE NOTE: The Alameda County HHW facilities can no longer accept most PRESCRIPTION DRUGS due to the DEA ban on accepting Controlled Substances. Prescription drugs and ointments, as well as any Controlled Substances, must be taken to one of the approved drop-off locations listed on the reverse side. These drop-off locations feature convenient self-service kiosks that accept Controlled Substances, as well as prescription and over-the-counter pills, creams, and liquids.

Special Handling Instructions:



Needles, Syringes, Lancets, Auto injectors and any other sharps including prescription drugs in preloaded syringes with needles must be packaged in approved sharps containers made with puncture and leak-resistant plastic and brought to a collection kiosk or HHW facility.



Pills should be poured out into Ziploc bags (it protects your privacy and lowers disposal costs). All of your pills may be mixed together in one bag.



Liquids and creams should be left in their original container with secure caps/lids. Black out any personally identifying information and place the container in a Ziploc bag.
