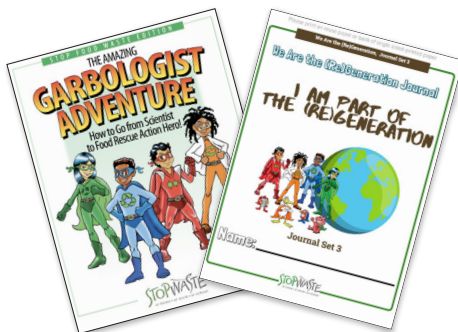


Digital Resources for Schools
